The Victoria Choral Society (VCS), directed by Brian Wismath, is an auditioned, mixed-voice symphonic choir of over one hundred singers, dedicated to presenting the finest large-scale choral music from baroque to contemporary. Founded in 1934, the Victoria Choral Society has played a leading role in Victoria's cultural life for ninety years.

Every year, in addition to singing as guest performers with other local artistic organizations such as the Victoria Symphony, Ballet Victoria and Festive Brass, the Victoria Choral Society also produces its own concerts.

Some of our past exciting programs include Bach's *Magnificat*, Beethoven's *Missa Solemnis*, Handel's *Joshua*, Mozart's *Requiem*, Mendelssohn's *Lobgesang*, Brahms' *Schicksalslied*, the world premiere of commissioned work *Nocturno* by Liova Bueno, Jonathan Dove's *The Passing of the Year*, Enn's *This Thirsty Land*, Gjeilo's *Luminous Night of the Soul*, Vivaldi's *Gloria*, and the Canadian premiere of Coleridge's *Requiem*.

On Sunday, May 19, 2024, VCS will be performing John Estacio's *The Houses Stand Not Far Apart* and Larysa Kuzmenko's *Golden Harvest* with members of the Victoria Symphony. *The Houses Stand Not Far Apart* pleads for peace, prays for understanding, and searches for hope. *Golden Harvest* follows the journey of one family, symbolic of all Ukrainian pioneers, who made the difficult decision to leave behind all that was familiar and dear to them to build a better life in Canada in the late 1800s and early 1900s. It chronicles hardships and achievements, which reflect a near-universal experience of immigrants everywhere: their journey, their struggle, and finally their settlement in their new land. The piece culminates in a celebration of the "Golden Harvest" Ukrainians brought to Canada: a harvest of precious wheat and uncountable cultural wealth.
